Upon receipt of your registration, the Show Committee will mail you entry cards, show rules and winning tips. The Show Committee will assign you a number. You will use this same number for all Exhibits entered in the show.

Categories and awards – In order to give entrants the ability to practice competing, we will use the 4-H sanctioned photo categories and scoring sheet, https://texas4-h.tamu.edu/wp-content/uploads/2018-19_texas_4h_photography_tules.pdf. The highest score in each Division and Category will receive an Award of Merit ribbon and a \$10.00 gift card. The entry ranked highest overall by Judges will be awarded the Photography Excellence Award ribbon and a \$50.00 gift card. A Sweepstakes Ribbon and \$50.00 gift card will be awarded to the exhibitor with the most photos entered in the Show. Peoples Choice ribbons will be awarded in each Division and Section. Winners will receive a Peoples Choice ribbon and \$25.00 gift card.

Judging - Each photograph will be judged against the set of judging criteria from the 4-H Score Sheet, and not against photographs of peers. Judges will determine the placings. Blue ribbons 90-100; Red ribbons 80-89, Yellow ribbons 70-79 points. Judging Panels will consist of Master Gardeners, Garden Council members, agents of Texas A&M AgriLife and experienced gardeners. All disputes will be settled by three (3) members of the Show Committee. All decisions will be final.
