Sections – Cut flowers, container grown plants for flowering, container grown plants for foliage, leaves, cacti and succulents, and herbs. Upon receipt of your registration, the Show Committee will mail you a list of suggested plants for all Sections, as well as entry cards, show rules and winning tips. The Show Committee will assign you a number. You will use this same number for all Exhibits entered in the show.

Awards and Ribbons - Highest score in each Division and Section will receive an Award of Merit ribbon and a \$10.00 gift card. The entry ranked highest overall by Judges will be awarded the Horticultural Excellence Award ribbon and a \$50.00 gift card. A Sweepstakes Ribbon and \$50.00 gift card will be awarded to the exhibitor with the most plants entered in the Show. Peoples Choice ribbons will be awarded in each Division and Section. Winners will receive a Peoples Choice ribbon and \$25.00 gift card.

Judging - Judges will award ribbons based on scoring of the plant. Blue ribbons 90-100; Red ribbons 80-89, Yellow ribbons 70-79 points. Judging Panels will consist of Master Gardeners, Garden Council members, agents of Texas A&M AgriLife and experienced gardeners. All disputes will be settled by three (3) members of the Show Committee. All decisions will be final.
