BACKPACK FOR TEEN FOSTER KIDS

This is a program to collect much needed items for teenage foster children. 75% of children in foster care are teenagers. They generally leave their homes with the clothes on their backs. By collecting these items, they are able to "shop" at the "Rainbow Room" at the CPS offices.

The "Rainbow Room" is for all foster children that are removed from their home to get some of the items that they need before being placed in a foster home. There is always an abundance of items for babies, but there is never anything for teenagers. By collecting these items, we are making them available to these youngsters that are in such need. This allows them to "shop" for the items that they would prefer.

We are collecting the following items:

- new/unused backpacks
- toiletry items (ex: brush, toothbrush, deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, razors, skin
- new in package underwear (boys and girls)
- new in package socks (no-show) thumb drives for the children to save their work at school (in case they are relocated).

We greatly appreciate your efforts in collecting these items for these very needy children! Items can be dropped off at the 4-H office and we will be glad to pick them up. We will be delivering these items monthly (hopefully).






