TEXAS 4-H HORSE VALIDATION

For the 2024 season will be open in 4HONLINE from March 1 through May 1, 2024. All horses must be validated/revalidated each year. The family can submit payment of \$10.00 per horse in the form of a credit card ONLY.

- From March 1 – April 15, the validation cost for each horse is \$10.00. The \$10.00 cost is only guaranteed if the animal validation is approved by the county office by the April 15 deadline and the payment is processed.
- From April 16 – May 1, the validation cost for each horse is \$20.00. The \$20.00 cost is only guaranteed if the animal validation is approved by the county office by the May 1 deadline and the payment is processed.
